ISBELL (LPD-869) IAW COMDESDIV 132 OPORDER No. 320-71. THIS SHIP IS GUIDE IN STATION ZERO IN A SECTOR SCREEN, WITH USS JOHN PAUL JONES IN SECTOR 3 LAS AND USS A.J. ISBELL IN SECTOR 3 BKS. SOPA, OTC AND CTU 15.9.6 IS COMDESDIV 132 EMBARKED IN THIS SHIP. FORMATION COURSE 019°T, SPEED 15 KTS. CONDITION OF READINESS IV AND MATERIAL CONDITION YOKE SET.
